Hello Parents:

We want to make you aware of a great learning and social opportunity for your child. On Friday, September 20th OR 27th, ^{we} will be spending the day in Ouray, Colorado.

While there, we will meet with San Juan Scenic Jeep Tours for an unforgettable adventure to the top of Yankee Boy Basin. After our jeep tour, we will be served lunch in the historic dining room of the downtown Western Hotel. The afternoon will consist of a guided tour through the ghost town of Ironton. We are fortunate to have a local guide with endless knowledge about the area, and he loves to tell tales about this very historic part of Colorado.

This trip costs \$55, which includes transportation, jeep tour, catered lunch, guided tour of Ironton and a commemorative t-shirt. Below is our itinerary for the day:

8:15 – Leave by bus for Ouray

10:30 – Meet with San Juan Jeep Tours

10:30 – Group A goes on jeep tour, Group B takes a tour of Ouray and heads to Ironton ←

1:00 – Lunch with both groups at the Historic Western Hotel

2:00 - Group B goes on jeep tour, Group A takes a tour of Ouray and heads to Box Canyon Falls

4:30 – All groups meet and board busses for home

6:00-6:30 Arrive back at RMS. **This is an approximate time, so Kids will call parents from busses when we get to Whitewater, and need to have arranged transportation prior to our morning departure. There IS NO bus service from Redlands Middle School.**

Items to bring include the following:

- Jacket/sweatshirt (temperatures on top of the mountain can be in the 50's)
- Hat (optional)
- Sunscreen (optional)
- NO flip flops
- Spending money in case we have time to go to Mousse's Chocolatier
